--"So the first shall be last and the last will be first." From this story, what do you think this means about Kingdom order?

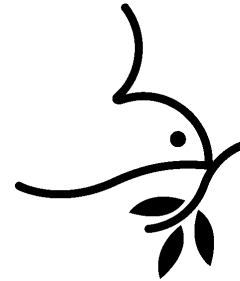
--Are there any missional lessons we can learn from Jesus' story?
