University Park COB is hoping to be a pickup site in the coming season for Lancaster Farm Fresh, an organic farmers' cooperative located in Leola, Pa. The cooperative is owned by nearly 70 Amish and Mennonite farmers growing certified-organic produce and raising grass-fed animals. Each week during a 28-week season, members will receive a box of vegetables and/or fruits filled with whatever is being harvested at that time (to be picked up during a designated window of time from UPCOB). Full memberships are \$120 for fruit shares and \$750 for vegetable shares, with half-shares of vegetables also available at \$450. See more details at www.lancasterfarmfresh.com. 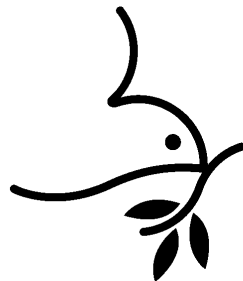
