**Cindy is attending** the installation of Amy Yoder McGlaughlin as pastor of the Germantown Mennonite Church, Germantown, Pa.

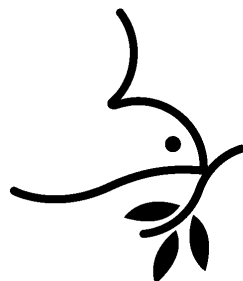
