--Are there missional lessons we can learn from Jesus’ story?

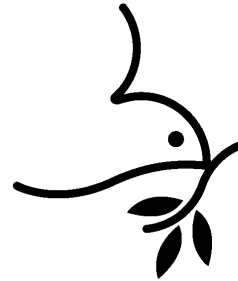
