(silence)

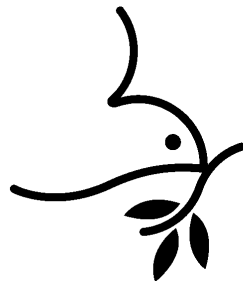
Leader - But who can detect one's own failings?
