Cindy will be in the church office Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday. She will be out of town on Thursday.

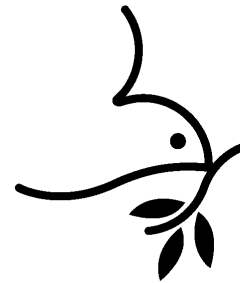
Adam will be in the office Tuesday through Friday.
