client to stay about a year and a half because the asylum process is so lengthy.

Christmas Eve offering this year will go to Mennonite Central Committee as they provide assistance in Pakistan. The summer of 2010 brought disastrous floods to many parts of Pakistan. MCC is working with Church World Service to provide shelter, food and relief kits to some of the 21 million people affected by the flooding. By some estimates, 100,000 babies were born in the last three months in the flood affected areas. The need is great. Thank you for your support.
