MDS Continues Tornado Response in Alabama and Begins in Joplin, Missouri. The devastating tornados that tore through the south on April 27-29 caused widespread damage in many states. In Alabama, 41 counties were affected. The first Alabama project location is in Birmingham. MDS has an urgent need for volunteers for short-term groups (one week stay) for clean up work starting May 22. The Missouri tornado kicked the Alabama tornado off the front page news, but the needs will go on and on in both locations. A tornado takes only minutes to destroy; the clean-up and rebuilding will take months and years. MDS is committed to being there to help people rebuild and return home. 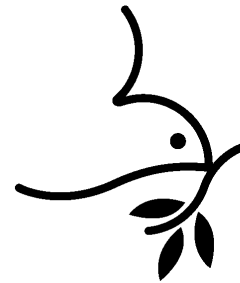
