She served as managing editor for *Hymnal: A Worship Book*. Recent publications include a DVD and biography of Mary K. Oyer (*Nurturing the Spirit Through Song*) and *Preparing Sunday Dinner*, a volume on leading worship co-written with Marlene Kropf and June Alliman Yoder.

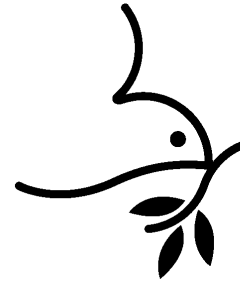
