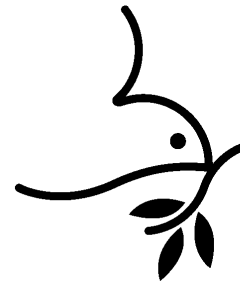
Church Staff Schedule: The church office is closed on Mondays.
