Vacation: Jake Short will be out of the office Jan. 18-27. Items for the bulletin can be directed to Nancy Gehman and Cindy Lapp.

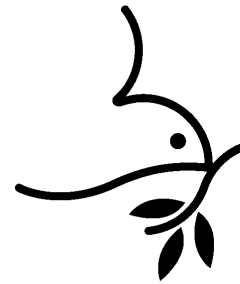
